

Transpose

To also transpose the name of the key in section titles and annotations, you must include them with square brackets [].

Ex. 1 - Using square brackets

This example is in the key of G

| | | | |
|-----------------------|-----------------------------|--------------------------|---------------------------------|
| <i>The tonic is G</i> | <i>the subdominant is C</i> | <i>the dominant is D</i> | <i>the parallel minor is Em</i> |
| G | C | D | Em |

Ex. 2 - Without square brackets

Attention, now only the chords are transposed correctly.

This example is in the key of G

| | | | |
|-----------------------|-----------------------------|--------------------------|---------------------------------|
| <i>The tonic is G</i> | <i>the subdominant is C</i> | <i>the dominant is D</i> | <i>the parallel minor is Em</i> |
| G | C | D | Em |

Change fonts to use the correct accidental symbols
