

Due to its position at the beginning of the line, it works only with short labels.
To add a floating title just prefix a regular section title with a "<".

There are mainly two use cases for the floating title.

Ex. 1

Add Labels To Musical Sections

... the verse part ...

... the chorus part ...

Add Bar Numbers

If you want to get fancy you can indent the chords to create some extra space for the floating title.

Note Floating titles use a reduced font size, numeric labels are italicized.
