

If you are working on a longer chart, you may want to temporarily disable some parts of the chart to better maintain focus.

You can do this with these special commands:

`EOT` end of transmission (end of text)

`BOT` begin of transmission (begin of text)

tip #1

My personal workflow often looks like this:

Start with copy and paste from another source.

Now I've mixed lyrics and chords, resulting in a very long and messy output.

That's why I'm prefixing what I have so far with an EOT to disable all rendering.

Then I work through the song piece by piece and add the revised parts before the EOT token.

When I'm done I can delete the EOT and any leftovers.

tip #2

To quickly toggle these special commands, you can comment them out with the # sign.

`#EOT` A comment will be completely ignored.
